Ursula King, STL (Paris), MA (Delhi), PhD (London) is Professor Emerita of Theology and Religious Studies, University of Bristol, England, where she held the Chair of Theology and Religious Studies (1989-2002) following lectureships at the University of Leeds, in London, and in India. She has lectured all over the world, published widely, and contributed to many broadcasts and TV programs. Formerly, Visiting Professor of Feminist Theology (University of Oslo), Brueggeman Chair in Interreligious Studies (Xavier University, Cincinnati), and distinguished Bingham Professor of Humanities (University of Louisville, Kentucky), she is currently Senior Research Fellow (Institute for Advanced Studies, University of Bristol), and has Fellowships in the Department of the Study of Religions, School of Oriental and African Studies and Heythrop College, both at the University of London. Her academic work is in the comparative study of religions, interfaith dialogue, spirituality, religion and gender, and the works of Pierre Teilhard de Chardin. Among her publications on Teilhard are the biography *Spirit of Fire, Teilhard de Chardin and Eastern Religions, Christ in All Things* (soon to be published in a revised edition), and *Pierre Teilhard de Chardin's Writings* in the Orbis Spiritual Masters Series. Ursula King holds honorary doctorates from the universities of Edinburgh (1996), Oslo (2000), and Dayton, Ohio (2003).
