John Grim, PhD has been President of the American Teilhard Association since 1987. He is Senior Lecturer and Research Scholar teaching in the joint MA program in religion and ecology at Yale University School of Forestry and Environmental Studies and in the Yale Divinity School. He is co-founder and co-director of the Forum on Religion and Ecology at Yale with his wife, Mary Evelyn Tucker. With Tucker, Grim directed “World Religions and Ecology,” a 10-conference series and book project at Harvard.

Grim is the author of *The Shaman: Patterns of Religious Healing Among the Ojibway Indians* (University of Oklahoma Press, 1983) and editor of *Indigenous Traditions and Ecology: The Interbeing of Cosmology and Community* (Harvard, 2001). Grim and Tucker are authors of *Ecology and Religion* (Island Press, 2014). and have edited the following volumes: *Worldviews and Ecology* (Orbis, 1994); *Religion and Ecology: Can the Climate Change?* (Daedalus, 2001); *The Christian Future and the Fate of Earth* (Orbis, 2009); *Thomas Berry: Selected Writings on the Earth Community* (Orbis, 2014); *Living Cosmology: Christian Responses to Journey of the Universe* (Orbis, 2016), and with Willis Jenkins the *Routledge Handbook on Religion and Ecology* (Routledge, 2017). John is the co-executive producer of the Emmy award winning film, *Journey of the Universe*. Tucker and Grim are currently working on a biography of Thomas Berry to be published by Columbia University Press.
