

Andrew Del Rossi, Th.D. received a doctoral degree in theology with a concentration in Christian Spirituality from La Salle University (2018). His doctoral dissertation is titled “Seeking Wholeness: Integrating Spirituality and Psychology in Pierre Teilhard de Chardin, Carl Jung, and Roberto Assagioli.” Presently, Del Rossi serves as Director of the Spirituality Center at Daylesford Abbey in Paoli, PA, where in collaboration with the Abbey’s Norbertine community, he has integrated Teilhard into the Center’s programming.
