R. Wayne Kraft is a professor of Materials Science and Engineering at Lehigh University in Bethlehem, Pennsylvania. After receiving a PhD in Metallurgical Engineering from the University of Michigan he served as research scientist at the United Aircraft Corp. and developed novel alloys for aircraft engines. In 1962 Dr. Kraft joined the faculty at Lehigh where he teaches undergraduate and graduate courses. Formerly president of the Bethlehem Council of Churches and lay leader of Cursillo in the Lehigh Valley, he is now a deacon-in-training for the Roman Catholic Diocese of Allentown. His wife Joan is a hospital chaplain; they are the parents of four grown children.
