Ursula King is professor and head of the department of Theology and Religious Studies at the University of Bristol, England. She is a former President of the European Society of Women in Theological Research (1993-95) and of the British Association for the Study of Religions (1991-94). She has published numerous articles and books among others Women and Spirituality, Voices of Protest and Promise (London: Macmillan and University Park: Penn State Press, 1993) and several edited volumes: Turning Points in Religious Studies (Edinburgh: T & T Clarke, 1990), Feminist Theology from the Third Word, A Reader (London: SPCK and Maryknoll, New York: Orbis Books, 1994), Religion and Gender (Oxford: Blackwell, 1995). She is also one of the co-editors of Religion in Europe, Contemporary Perspectives (Kampen: KOK Pharos, 1994).

In earlier years, Ursula King published two studies on Pierre Teilhard de Chardin. She has just completed a new biography of Teilhard (Orbis, 1996) and is currently working on Teilhard's understanding of spirituality for her forthcoming Bampton Lectures to be given at Oxford University in the spring of 1996. She is President of the British Teilhard Association.
