Winifred McCulloch is a graduate of Radcliffe College with a degree in History and Literature. In Athens and Rome she drew illustrations for archeological publications. She has written background material for museum exhibitions and has edited and contributed chapters to several books.

She gained insight into the world of science while at the Institute for Advanced Study (Princeton) collating early Latin manuscripts for E.A. Lowe. Wishing to explore the implications of Teilhard's idea that matter, mind, consciousness and spirit are inseparable phenomena of a single unbroken evolving cosmos, she joined the American Teilhard Association, became an officer, and is editor of *Teilhard Perspective*.
